Dear Parents/Guardians of Sayles School students,

We are writing to update you regarding the transition of school back to normal operations. As part of our reopening plan, students will begin this transition back to daily, onsite learning on Tuesday, October 13, 2020 (the day after the Columbus Holiday), when all Sayles School students currently in cohorts A and B will begin attending school in person for four days per week. We ask that families be aware that bus pick-up and drop-off times may vary from what they have been in September due to the increased number of students.

Wednesday's instruction for students will only be on-line learning and Wednesdays will continue to be used to clean and disinfect the building. The time on Wednesday will also allow teachers to touch base with on-line students. In November, we hope to be able to conclude the transition back to normal operations with students attending school in person all five days per week.

Families may continue to choose to have their students participate with on-line learning for all five days. It is important to remember that attendance is being taken for students who are participating in online learning. All students are expected to be accessing their education five days per week. The distance learning option will be available until the State Department of Education decides to discontinue it. We will notify you when that happens.

We would like to thank all of you for your support and flexibility as we transition back to full operations. Working together, we can continue to keep our students and community safe. As always, if you have any questions concerning our reopening plan, please do not hesitate to contact us.
